- **Security updates**

- In recent weeks, non-state armed groups have carried out several attacks on small towns in the districts of Nangade, Macomia and Palma, triggering a military reaction, mainly from Rwandan forces.
- The most recent attack occurred in the coastal town of Quiterajo in Macomia district has been claimed by the so-called Islamic State in Mozambique Province, as opposed to the usual ISCAP claims, suggesting an internal split or power struggle within the organization.
- Overall, the security situation has improved in the last two months, mainly thanks to the Rwandan military intervention in the districts of Nangade, Macomia, Palma and Mueda, which is likely to continue in the coming months.
- All 3700 people displaced from villages by armed attacks in Mecula, Niassa, in December and January and who had been sheltering in the district town have returned home according to Government officials.

## **Other updates:**

- Mozambique has secured an IMF grant (\$470 million) to be disbursed over the next 10 years at zero interest.
- The pacification of northern Mozambique will allow Oil & Gas companies to resume their activities in Cabo Delgado, something that is not yet clear to happen in 2022, although the need for alternative fuel sources due to the Russian-Ukrainian conflict could change this situation.
- Despite recent announcements by the Mozambican government that grain and fuel shortages are unlikely in the coming weeks/months, the rising prices of these commodities are proving otherwise, and if it continues, the situation has the potential to trigger social protests and civil unrest across the country. In relation to fuel shortages, transporters threatened to launch a strike if fuel prices continue to rise, which is likely to happen in the coming weeks/months.

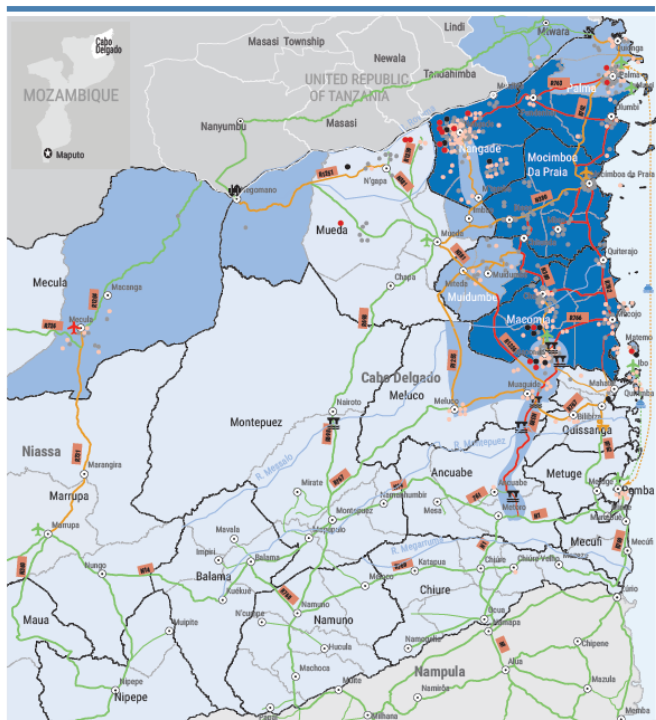

## DISPLACEMENT TRACKING MATRIX - Mozambique EMERGENCY TRACKING TOOL (ETT)

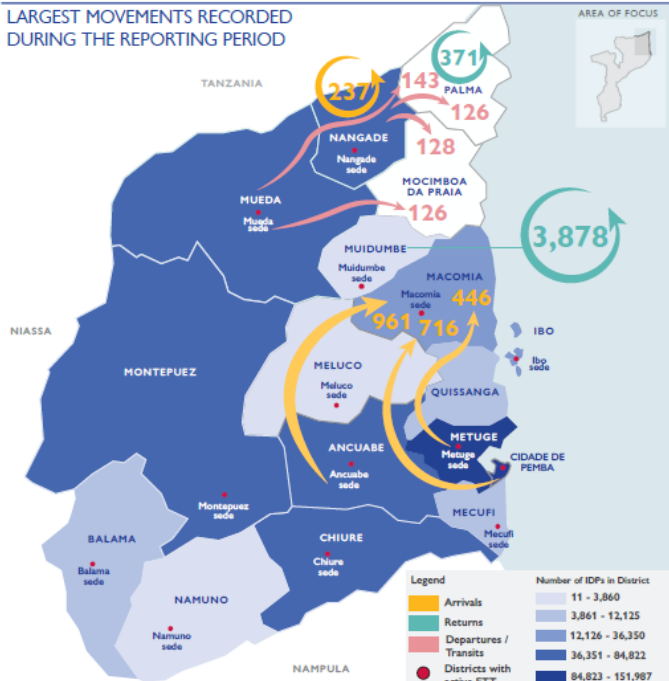
DTM Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is deployed to track and provide up-to-date information on sudden displacement and other population movements



ETT Report: No. 158/04 - 10 May 2022

During the reporting period (04 to 10 May 2022), a total of 76 movements were recorded - 28 returns (4,487 individuals), 29 arrivals (2,580 individuals), 16 departures (398 individuals), and 3 transits (249 individuals). The largest return movements were recorded in Muidumbe (3,878 individuals), Palma (371 individuals) and Macomia (158 individuals). The largest arrival movements were recorded in Macomia (2,319 individuals), and Nangade (237 individuals). The largest departure movement was observed in Nangade (285 individuals). The largest transit movement was observed in Mueda (249 individuals). Of the total population, 6 per cent of mobile groups were displaced for the first time, and 94 per cent of reported individuals have been displaced more than once prior to this movement.

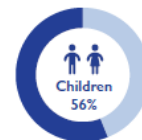

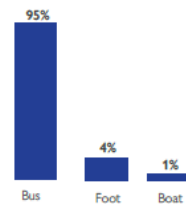
### MAIN REPORTED NEEDS



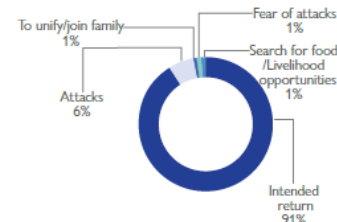
### MAIN DISTRICTS OF ORIGIN (for arrivals)



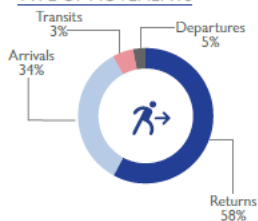
### MEANS OF DISPLACEMENT



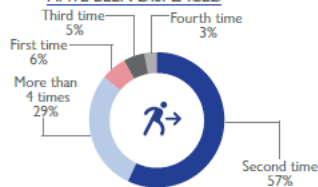
### TRIGGERS OF MOVEMENT (for all arrival, return, departures and transit movements)



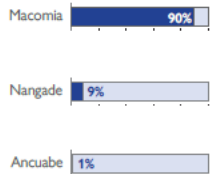
### TYPE OF MOVEMENTS



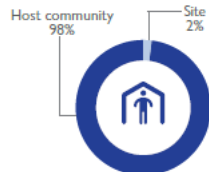
### NUMBER OF TIMES IDPs HAVE BEEN DISPLACED



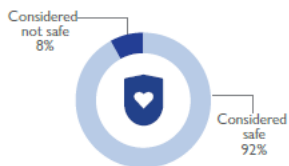

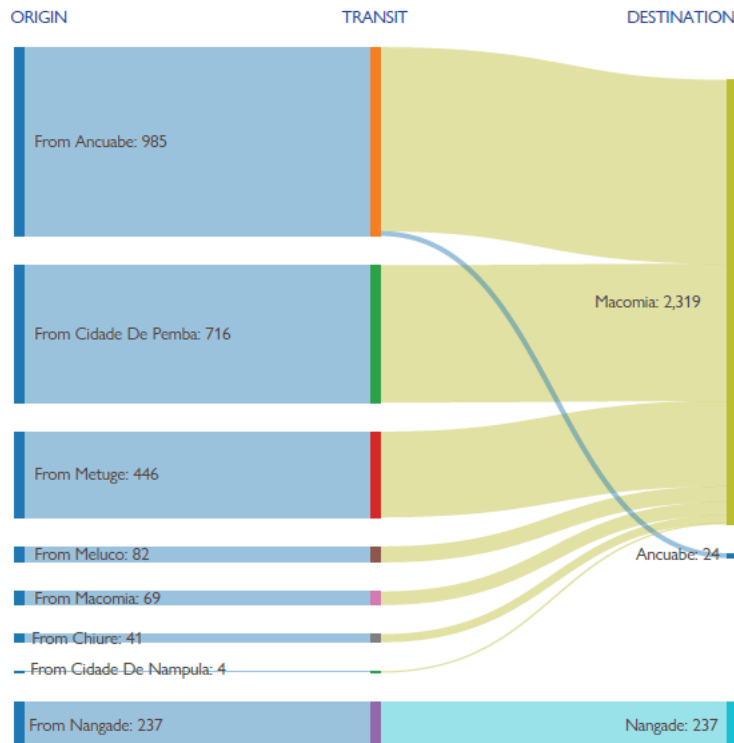

- Partners (ADRA; FH and Iris Global) continued their food assistance;
- Important notes:
  - FH is going to interrupt food assistance this month and change to seeds distributions and agricultural technical assistance in the supported sites;
  - Iris Global to reinforce support (food assistance) in Nacala;
- CARE: meeting to discuss possible cash support component in coming projects;
- FAO: fisheries report on the impact of the insurgency crisis.

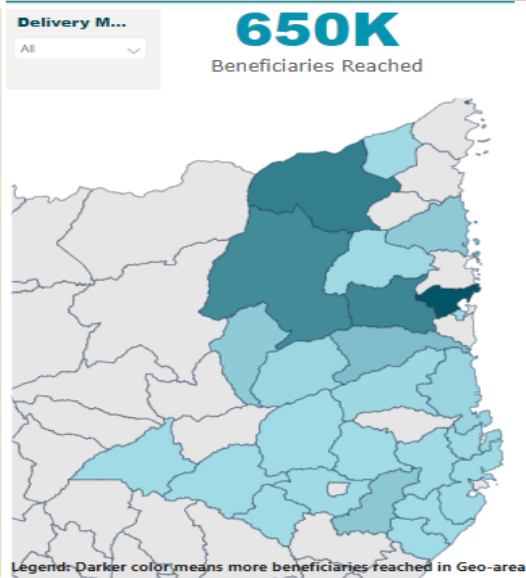

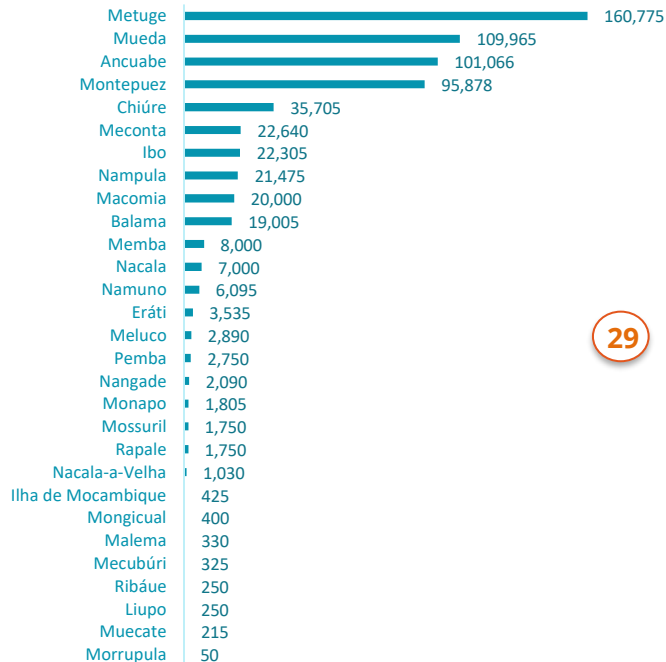

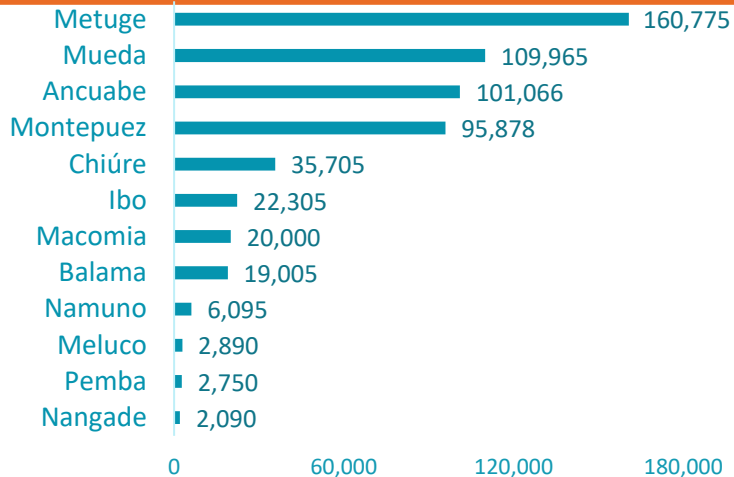

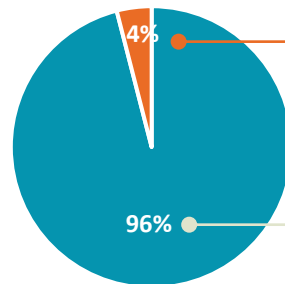

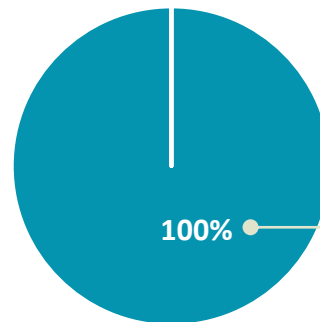
## TOTAL OF BENEFICIARIES REACHED BY INDICATOR

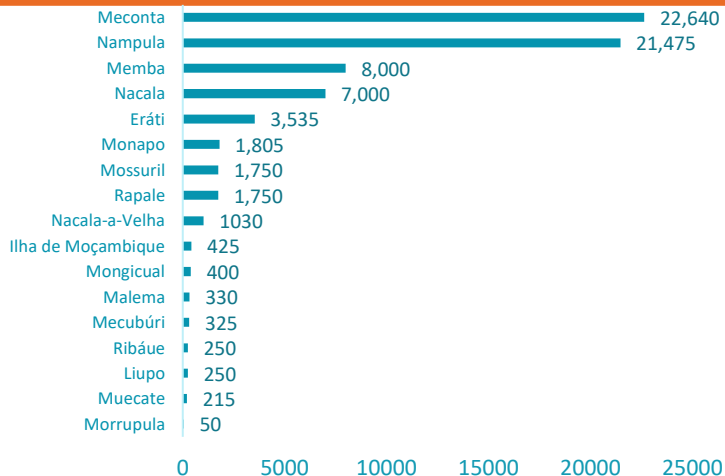

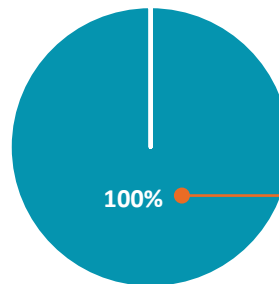

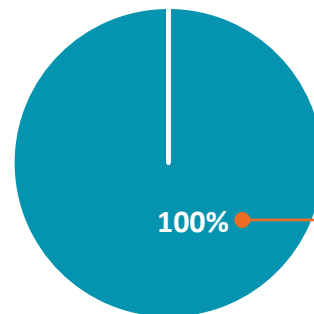

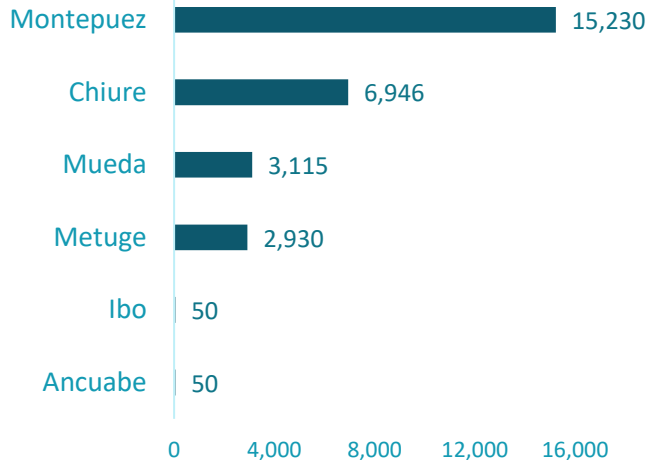

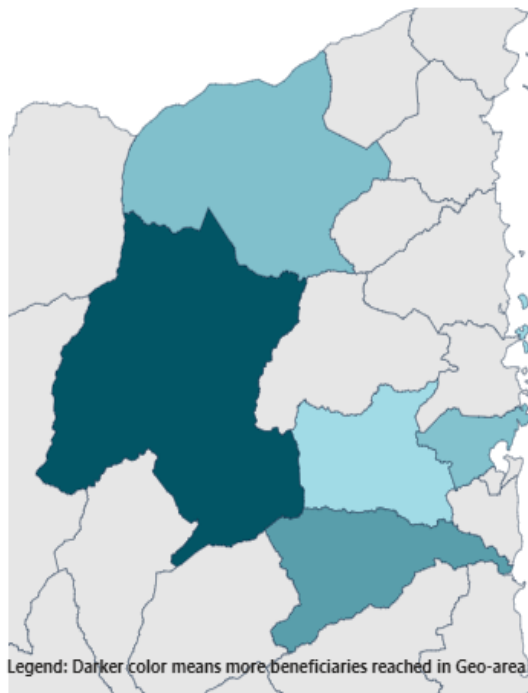
## MAP: TOTAL OF BENEFICIARIES REACHED BY DISTRICT

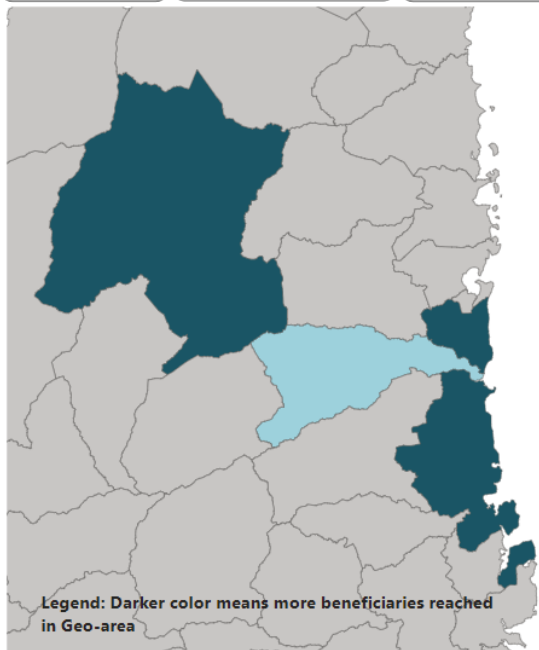

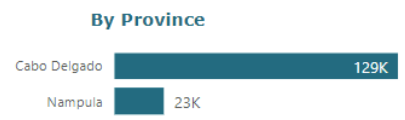
