FOOD SECURITY




Food security exists when all people, at all times, have physical and economic access to sufficient safe and nutritious food that meets their dietary needs and food preferences for an active and healthy life.

FOUR MAIN COMPONETS OF FOOD SECURITY



THE CLUSTER APPROACH





Ukraine Humanitarian Response

- 10 out of 11 clusters activated; and 3 sub-clusters
 - 261 humanitarian responders—of which 163 are national NGOs, 54 INGOs, 9 government institutions, 8 UN agencies, 5 international organizations, 4 private entities and 18 other responders (OCHA 2022).

THE CLUSTER APPROACH




The Cluster approach:

- Builds partnerships
- Coordinates responses of all agencies responding to the emergency
- Provides a mechanism for predictability and accountability to beneficiaries
- Advocates for addressing response gaps
