Flash Appeal Strategic Objective

Strategic Objective 01: Provide principled and timely life-saving multi-sectoral assistance to people affected by the war considering gender, age, and diversity approaches.

Strategic Objective 02: Protect conflict-affected people and civilian infrastructure considering gender, age and disability approaches, and advocate for parties to the conflict to uphold their obligations under international humanitarian law.

Strategic Objective 03: Support provision of essential and gender-response services both in areas impacted by the conflict and in locations hosting displaced people.





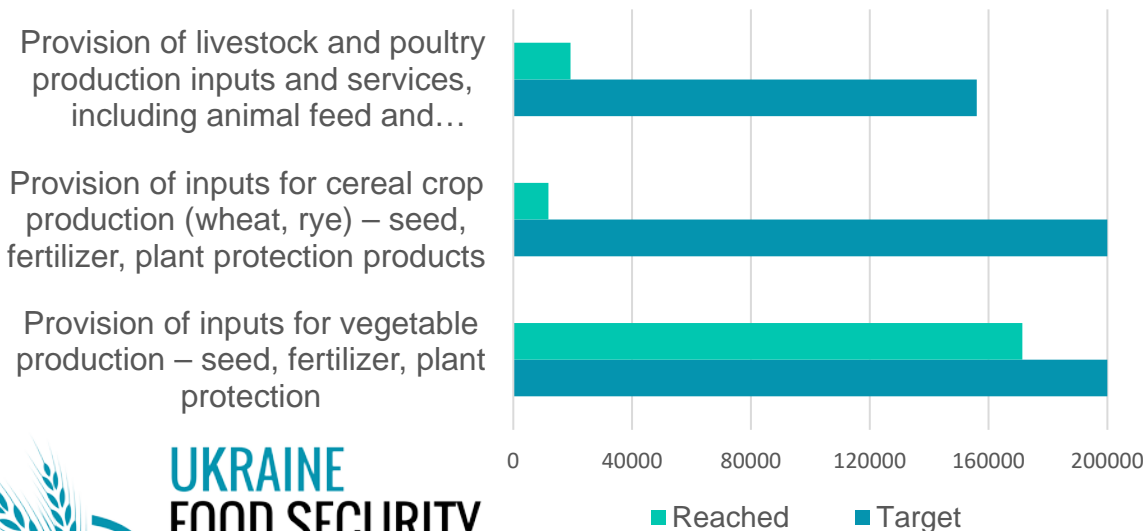
FSL Cluster Objectives

SO1	Provision of inputs for cereal crop production (wheat, rye) – seed, fertilizer, plant protection products.	# of household provided with farm or garden inputs.
SO1	Provision of inputs for vegetable production – seed, fertilizer, plant protection.	# of households provided or supported.
SO1	Provision of livestock and poultry production inputs and services, including animal feed and mineral/vitamin supplements.	# of individuals provided or supported with livestock/poultry feed and mineral supplements kits disaggregated by age and gender.
SO1	Cash/inputs for farmers to support winterization.	# of individuals receiving cash and agriculture livelihood support disaggregated by age and gender.
SO1	Cash or voucher assistance for the repair of livestock shelter damaged by the conflict.	# of individuals supported with cash or vouchers to repair livestock shelters disaggregated by age and gender.

SO1	Repair of grain and vegetable storage damaged by the conflict	# of individuals supported with repairs of their grain and vegetable storage disaggregated by age and gender.
SO1	Distribution of grain storage facilities	# of individual farmers receiving grain storage facilities.
SO1	Addressing lost income through rapid reskilling, vocational training programmes and job creation.	# of individuals receiving new professional skills and competencies and employed - disaggregated by age and gender.
SO1	Support to job creation by small businesses through grants/income generation provision of equipment and tools.	# of small businesses supported with grants/income generation activities disaggregated by women and men led small businesses.
