LBA/COAR discussion of evacuations and request for information on conditions in Kherson

Josh Nadeau presented a situation report for Kherson.

Key points:

- Residents haven't had access to proper utilities since November
- Food security situation has improved. Presence of humanitarian actors, functioning food markets
- Livelihood situation is complicated. Lack of employment opportunities, poor access to farmland due to UXO contamination
- Social payments are delayed and hard to come by
- The Ministry of Reintegration of Ukraine provides evacuation opportunities
