
GFD Round 7 and 8

- <u>Round 7 completed</u>: Distribution started 23rd of December and will end the 9th of January, WFP and 7 NGOs (3 NGOs complementary food assistance)
- <u>Round 8 starting today</u>: distribution to start the 16th of January until the 28th of January, WFP and 6 NGOs (2 NGOs complementary food assistance)

What's Different?

- Refugee Food Management Committee
 - Rohingya food distribution volunteers, porters and Majis who perform well in identifying manipulations and community mobilization in the team. Pay them @250 BDT/day.
- Proactive information sharing w/ CiC and SMS Actors
 - distribution catchment and plan to be shared before starting GFD round. Also, inform CiCs that we will periodically liaise with them to verify complaints.
 - Any new caseload/complaints/missing households should be verified before inclusion in ongoing GFD cycle. Please do not distribute new GFD cards, without approval of WFP.
- New Caseload and verification of complaints
 - missing HHs lodge their complaints at CP's help/complaint desk at distribution points.
 - All CPs to consolidate their complaints of missing households in a 3 day-cycle,
 - Every 4th day of GFD cycle, CPs to work with CiC, SMS focal agencies (UNHCR/IOM) and majhi's to verify eligible caseloads before integrating them into the ongoing GFD cycle.
 - CP also to conduct random door-to-door verification for data triangulation
 - Absentee beneficiaries and verified complaint-caseloads to collect food ration every 5th day
 - New arrivals will receive a food card based on UNHCR FCN card, and integrated to ongoing GFD

- <u>Purpose</u>: review of the JRP proposals and ensure that are in line with the FSS Strategy, include all relevant information (including cross-cutting issues), budget and organization capacity;

- <u>Next steps:</u>
- SRC to meet for reviewing the timeline, process and template;
- Project proposal will be submitted to the Sector secretariat;
- SRC will receive the project proposals and first screen review;
- SRC will meet and integrate the comments in a unique template;
- Sector to send back the comment to the FSS members;
- Agencies to review the proposals in line with comments and submit it again; BANGLADESH

VALUE:

Top-up current GFD (cereal+pulses+fat)

<u>TOTAL VALUE</u>: 824 *5 = **4,120**

- a) TOTAL VALUE GFD: 678 *5 = 3,390
- b) TOTAL VALUE FRESH FOOD: 146 *5 = 730



Food groups:

Food groups to be considered:

- a) Vegetable (onions)
- b) Fish
- c) Sugar/Salt
- d) Vegetable (leaves, dark green, e.g. spinach)
- e) Miscellaneous (spiced mix/garlic)



Target:

- a) Most vulnerable? Profile according to REVA analysis
- b) Blanket by site?
- c) Special health deficiencies cases (health, nutrition)
