
#### **GFD Round 8 and 9**


- Round 8 completed: Distribution started 16<sup>th</sup> of January and end on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January, WFP and 7 NGOs (3 NGOs complementary food assistance): more than 124,000 HHs reached
- Round 9: distribution started on the 4<sup>th</sup> of February until the 15<sup>th</sup> of February, WFP and 6 NGOs (2 NGOs complementary food assistance): 192,000 HHs to be reached
- Round 9 will include ALL HHs size (1-3, 4-7, 8+)
- Refugees relocations support in coord with UNHCR/IOM

The monsoon season will last for 7 months (April – October)

- 1. GFD to continue: distribution points to be enhanced, road, access, log hub
- GFD to be transferred to e-voucher system (90,000 now + 90,000 new refugees in March) and 11 new shops to be built;
- Fortified biscuits and cooked meals distributions to be continued for most vulnerable and new influx;
- Fresh food top up distributions (access to market) to be continued

#### Main challenges:

Access: access to distribution points will be difficult especially for the most vulnerable;

**Mitigation:** improve the road to distribution points (cash for work, FFA), use of volunteers/ porters to bring food to distribution points from log hub; porters to support the most vulnerable to access their rations;

Cooking fuel: firewood utilization will be more difficult

Mitigation: LPG to be distributed (shelter/nfi sector), self-reliance packages and training, common kitchen to be established for sharing cooking utilities; BANGLADESH ECOLORIST SECURITY SEC

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In case of shock (cyclone, flood, landslide)

- 1. Scale up distribution of <u>fortified biscuits</u> as emergency response for the first 72hrs
- 2. Scale up the production of <u>cooked meals</u> to target the most vulnerable/displaced/relocated;

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3. <u>Mobile distribution</u> of food where necessary and/or readdress the GFD to new area (if relocation will be possible)

**Assumption:** 102,000 people to directly affected by landslide/flood

**Fortified biscuits**: WFP – 100,000 (yearly plan) monsoon pipeline to be confirmed;

Cooked meals: 9+1 kitchen serving 14,500 individuals/day to be scaled up (ACF): capacity 10,000 individuals/day/kitchen

Cooked meals: 30,000 individuals/day (TIKA);

Cash for work/FFA: 10,000 individuals to be involved for distribution points access enhancement;

Porters: additional workers to be involved
