


## **GFD Round 12 & 13**

- Round 12: Distribution started 19<sup>th</sup> 29<sup>th</sup> March, WFP and 6 NGOs.
- Round 12 planned to distribute among 107,839
   HHs and reached 104,645 HHs (470,902 individuals approximately)
- Round 13: Started on 03<sup>rd</sup> April and will run till 16<sup>th</sup> April and plan to distribute to 150,189 HHs and as of 08<sup>th</sup> April 71,002 HHs has reached.
- e-Vouchers: 200,000 people enrolled in shops





- Total funded now: 22,5 Mln (food assistance + livelihoods)




