ACF:

- Has full out of Gujba, Mutai and Gotala wards of Gujba LGA.
- In Fune LGA, 6 wards will benefit for 6 months for unconditional CT to the sum of N 25,000.

Yobe Pilot Livestock Development Project (YPLDP)

- The project was established by WB to carry out the following activities:
 - Animal Disease control and Vaccination.
 - Extension guide on Livestock promotion.
 - Grazing reserve development/ fodder Bank establishment.
 - Advocacy to livestock farmers.
 - Earth Dam construction for Animal Water drinking.
 - Ease livestock movement etc.
- The project was revised in 2007 to be continued in the state.
- Serves as a SP for FAO in implementing:
 - Medication/Vaccination and Drug administering activates.
 - Quarantine.
 - Animal Feeds Distribution among others.

FAO:

- Rain season project completed.
- Call for expression of Interest for Dry Season project implementation in 9 LGAs of the Yobe, invitations issued for INGOs,NGOs and Government agencies. The project will provide 3 kits of Vegetable seeds, fertilizers and rice seed to beneficiaries
- Likely there will be additional 2 LGAs for the project.
- Extensive discussion on livestock support is going on for women (Small Ruminant support) and youths (Bulls for fattening)and PO has been issued out for procurement.
