4	Discussion on Food Security Situation in the State. A good number of farmers are selling their farm produce immediately after harvest and some even sell it at the farm gate. This will have a negative effect in the long run especially during lean season when food stocks at the Household level gets depleted and prices usually goes up. To access food for most of the Households during the lean period is difficult	All

A total of 1,770 HHs were reached with 3,280 goats kits, 19,000 noiler kits, 2,300 bags of growers' mash, 1,640 bags each of cotton seed cake and cowpea husks as well as 820 mineral salt licks. • Localization training to 20 FSS national partners in Adamawa. <p>Mercy Corps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 155 (136 males, 19 females) farmers from Fufore, Jada, Michika, Girei, Ganye, Demsa and Madagali were trained on wheat production. • 10 wheat demo plots established in Ngurore and Kapo communities of Yola South and Fufore LGAs where 1013 farmers were reached with improved agronomic practices.
