


United Refuge is a US based non-profit organization that supports communities on the front lines of global fragility.

Internally displaced, refugees and asylum seekers. * preliminary figure ** preliminary figure as of May Source: UNHCR










The world is woefully unprepared for the current and coming crisis of displaced people. As even current global crisis fail to reach their funding goals.

Ukraine Response

Since February 2022, our team has provided technical support to over 75 Community Service Organizations in Ukraine and Poland through:

- Shelter Technical assistance
 - Facility repairs at orphanages, IDP and refugee centers
- Grant facilitation
 - Compilation of Requests for Assistance
 - Dissemination of grants
- Technical support
 - Office and Field support
 - Quality control mechanisms
 - Education on Humanitarian standards.
- Local Network in Ukraine
 - Active in 11 Oblasts
