


Ukraine: recent dynamics & pol implications

- Mass passportization in Zaporizska and Kherson oblast announced, similarly as with the 860,000 residents in Donetsk and Luhansk prior to 24 February.
- This signals the RF preference for integration (also economically) of those territories rather than pushing for additional autonomous Republics.
- If referendum will be held for annexation of Mariupol, Kherson, Donbas Donetsk and Luhansk people's republics this might coincide with 11 September Russian elections
- **Ukranian recent military successes**: pushing the RF away from Kharkiv, limiting RF forces north of K; blocking from south of Izyum the RF offensive towards Slovyansk and Kramatorsk, increasingly under attack from south & east;



Ukraine: most likely scenario next 2 weeks


• RF -already controlling 80-90% of Donbas: Slow but steady road-based RF offensive in Luhansk: focus on Severodonetsk, now almost fully encircled: contested are between SD, Slovyansk and Kramatorsk (75 miles wide)





Ukraine Limited Emergency Operation (LEO)

 north of Slovyansk, Lyman is and will be under increased attack, but most of the attack on S & K will come from the south due to Seversky Donetsk acting as UKR defensive line, so focus on RF offensive from Popasna westward towards Bakhmut and then from there to Slovyansk





Ukraine: most likely scenario next 2 weeks

- In the **south**, increased fighting to be expected in the contested area between Kherson city and Mykolaiv.
- UKR resistance emerging in Melitopol.
- Increased missile strikes to be expected on Odesa from Filatovka in north Crimea
- Odesa remaining safe from the land until Mykolaiv is taken by RF, which remains unlikely
- Likely uptick of offensive operations towards Zaporizhia and Kryvyi Rih.
